

**Dunn Township  
Meeting Minutes  
Monday June 10, 2013  
Dunn Town Hall 7:00 pm**

The meeting was called to Order by Chairman D. Johnson. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present.

Supervisor D. Seifert was absent from the meeting.

**Agenda Approval-** Motion made by Kvaré, seconded by Pare 'to approve the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

**Meeting Minutes-** Motion made by Pare', seconded by Dalman, to approve the minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

**Correspondence:**

**New Business-** The clerk was directed to get estimates for carpeting. D. Johnson will spray for ants and weeds.

**Treasurers Report-** Motion made by Kvaré', seconded by Pare', to approve the Treas. Report as presented. Motion passed unanimously. The OTC check received from current property taxes was \$ 245,939.98.

**Claims List-** Motion made by Pare', seconded by Dalman, to accept the claims in the amount of \$ 12,320.61 with the addition of the payroll of \$ 1,325.22 for a total of \$ 13,645.83. Motion passed unanimously.

**Township Engineer Report-** J. Stabnow: Recommendations were made for 2 blind approach signs to be placed at the Lazy Acres Campground (by Zion Church).

Brush cutting in the area should also be done by the property owner.

**Fish Lake Road:** The culvert at Radamachers location was cleaned out and the Clemson leveler was placed. Water levels are down and have stabilized.

Stabnow stated that it is approx. \$ 19,000-20,000 per mile for seal coating.

Quotes will be received at the July 8, 2013 meeting for the 2013 paving project.

**Citizen Agenda Requests:** Residents from Broadwater Beach requested that the intersection at 215<sup>th</sup> be changed for safety issues. Les Rotz from Scambler Township commented that they will have to meet to make a determination how to proceed. Motion made by Kvare, seconded by Dalman, to put a speed limit sign and/or a stop ahead sign if Dunn Township has jurisdiction on the SE side of 215<sup>th</sup> intersection, encouraging Scambler to do the same. Motion passed unanimously. \* Note: 215<sup>th</sup> Ave. is shared by Dunn and Scambler Township. Dunn maintains the southern 1 ½ mile and Scambler the northern 1 ½ mile. Motion made by Kvare, seconded by Pare' to make contact with the OTC Sheriff's office to step up enforcement (i.e.: parking along the Fish Lake Road). Motion passed unanimously. D. Lockler stated that 4 residents on Poss Beach have lost their mail boxes. Lockler stated 2 way plows should be used. C. Kvare stated that the new plows for the State of MN will only be 2 way plows. D. Johnson stated that residents should not move snow into the road right of way.

**PVHD-**Representative Slotten's report is on file.

**Old Business:** Kvare stated that R. Nyklemoe will review the Moug/Zimmerman description (again) and a new resolution will then be drafted and recorded. A fee schedule for future road vacates will also need to be established to cover expenses.

**Town Board Matters to be Addressed-** Road Tour: Delineators are needed on Labrador Beach. M. Johnson will order them. Contact needs to be made to the MN DOT regarding the approach at Sven Rostads. A proposed cost sheet of estimated expenses for the 2013 summer projects was distributed to all of the Supervisors for review.
