**Establish Steeple Chase Lane as a town road
June 8, 2019 at 9:00am
Dunn Town Hall**

Call to Order: The hearing was called to order by Chairman D. Johnson at 9:00am. Supervisors present: Herseith, Seifert, Dalman, Nyquist. Clerk Winter. In the audience: Bruce Fadness.

Pledge of Allegiance: The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Petition to Establish Steeple Chase Lane as a town road: A copy of the petition was received and verified. Please note that the recording of Steeple Chase Lane cannot be done without the original petition.

Comments from the Public: None.

Comments from the township board members: The board of Supervisors reviewed the work that must be completed before the road can be accepted as a town road. They need to have 1 ½ inches of class five installed and compacted. That installation is delayed due to difficulty in having the product delivered. Brush and trees in the 66 foot right of way must be removed. It was stated that Arntson Construction will clear the right of way. We will dust guard the roadway after it is accepted as a town road. The roadway needs to be reviewed and approved by the township engineer before the Resolution to accept the roadway as a township road can be initiated.

Motion: The motion to accept the roadway as a Dunn Town road will be done after all of the stipulated items have been taken care of. Gravel, Brush/Tree removal, Original of the petition received by the township clerk.
