

**Dunn Township Resolution #2025-01 -
Retail Sale of Cannabis and Lower-Potency Hemp Edible
Registration Authority Delegation to Otter Tail County
Dunn Township
Otter Tail County, Minnesota**

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota passed legislation codified under Minnesota Chapter 342 legalizing the sale of lower-potency hemp edibles and cannabis products; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Cannabis Management (OCM) is the state regulatory office created to oversee the implementation and regulation of the adult-use cannabis market, the medical cannabis market, and consumer hemp industry; and

WHEREAS, the OCM governs the application and licensing process for cannabis hemp businesses; and

WHEREAS, after an applicant has been approved for licensing by the OCM, the business is required to receive a local government's retail registration; and

WHEREAS, Dunn Township is not adopting an ordinance to regulate the retail sale of cannabis and lower-potency edibles at this time; and

WHEREAS, Dunn Township is delegating its registration authority for the retail sale of cannabis and lower-potency hemp edibles to Otter Tail County.

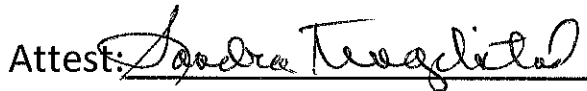
